Scripture: Proverbs 31:10 (*NIV*)

Synopsis: What exactly is the going rate for a ruby these days? And if moms are worth more, how do we even afford them? Spoiler alert: you can't. Moms are basically the spiritual equivalent of owning a fleet of Lamborghini's, a private jet, a cozy resort island, and a lifetime supply of coffee. In other words, moms are priceless.

What I know about mom!

I. Mom is worth more than a shopping spree at Kay Jewelers.

<u>Proverbs 31:10</u> – A wife of noble character who can find? She is worth far more than rubies.

II. Mom has eyes in the back of her head.

<u>Psalm 139:2-3</u> – You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.


