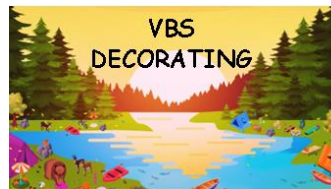

“What I Know About the Devil”

Scripture: Genesis 3:1-6 (NIV)

Synopsis: There is a mad man who infiltrated the Garden of Eden to destroy Adam and Eve’s relationship with God and he will do everything in his power to infiltrate your life. He is called the devil. He is out to kill, steal, and destroy. So, be on the lookout for this deadly demon.

What I know about the Devil:

I. He appears _____ we least expect him.

The Devil is going to show up when everything seems to be perfect.

1 Peter 5:8 – *Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.*

II. He appears in _____ we least expect him.

Genesis 3:1 – *Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, “Did God really say, ‘You must not eat from any tree in the garden?’”*

Satan is very attractive.

Ezekiel 28:12-15 – *Son of man, take up a lament concerning the king of Tyre and say to him: ‘This is what the Sovereign Lord says: “You were the seal of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. You were in Eden, the garden of God; every precious stone adorned you:*

carnelian, chrysolite and emerald, topaz, onyx and jasper, lapis lazuli, turquoise and beryl. Your settings and mountings were made of gold; on the day you were created they were prepared. You were anointed as a guardian cherub, for so I ordained you. You were on the holy mount of God; you walked among the fiery stones. You were blameless in your ways from the day you were created till wickedness was found in you.”

Isaiah 14:12-15 – *How you have fallen from heaven, morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations! You said in your heart, “I will ascend to the heavens; I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on the mount of assembly, on the utmost heights of Mount Zaphon. I will ascend above the tops of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High.” But you are brought down to the realm of the dead, to the depths of the pit.*

III. He speaks in _____ we least expect him.

Genesis 3:1b – *... He said to the woman, “Did God really say, ‘You must not eat from any tree in the garden?’”*

The moment you start putting a question mark after the word of God, you will be headed down a fast and slippery slope.

Genesis 3:2-3 – *The woman said to the serpent, “We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, but God did say, ‘You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.’”*

He is the biggest liar and he tells lies about the biggest subject – God!

Genesis 3:4-5 – *“You will not surely die,” the serpent said to the woman. “For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.”*

Sin is enjoyable, but it is short lived.

Hebrews 11:25 - *He [Moses] chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time.*

Genesis 3:6 – *When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it.*

When you ignore the Word of God, you become the ultimate decision maker as to what is right and to what is wrong.

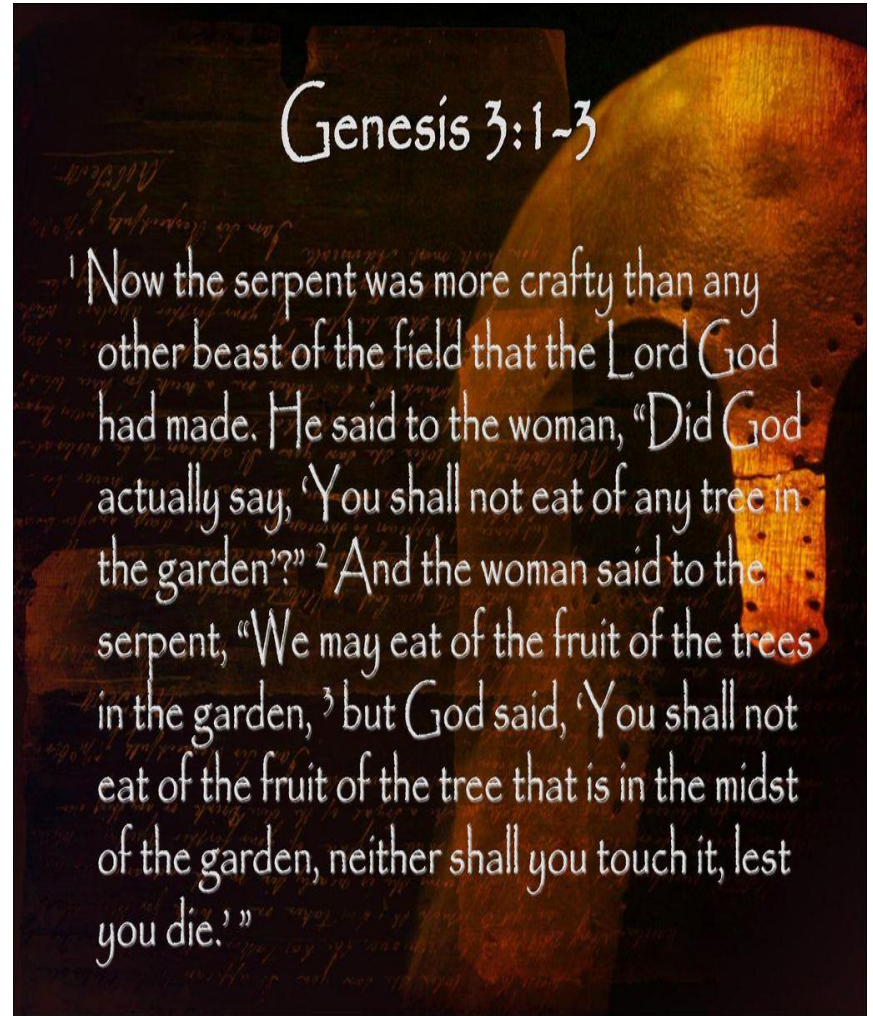
Genesis 3:3 – *You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.*

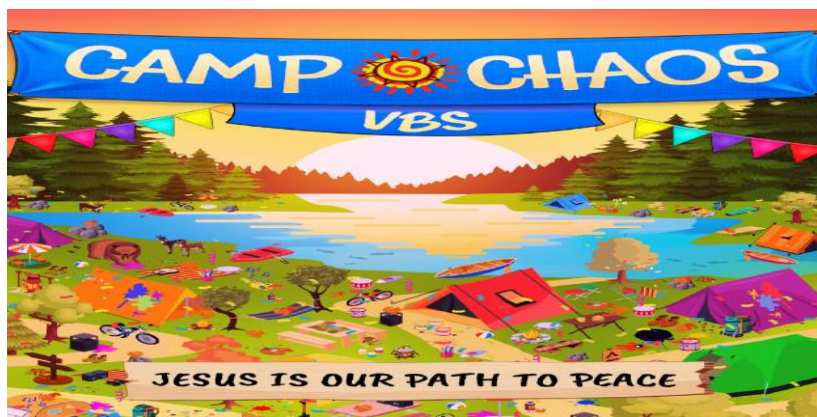
Sin not only hurts you, but others.
