

"A Foolish Father" By Pastor Dennis Felder June 16, 2025

Scripture: 1 Samuel 3:11-13 (*NIV*)

Synopsis: Though Eli served in the house of the Lord, he failed in one of the most critical responsibilities entrusted to him: Fatherhood. Fathers can learn from Eli's mistake and choose to lead their homes with conviction, courage, and an unwavering commitment to God's truth.

A foolish father will:

I.	Ignore God's	

<u>1 Samuel 3:11</u> – And the Lord said to Samuel: "See, I am about to do something in Israel that will make the ears of everyone who hears about it tingle.

God will use tragic events in your life to get your attention.

<u>Job 33:29-30</u> – God does all these things to a person—twice, even three times—to turn them back from the pit, that the light of life may shine on them.

When a father ignores God's warning, he will lose respect.

<u>Proverbs 13:18</u> – Whoever disregards discipline comes to poverty and shame, but whoever heeds correction is honored.

A wise father will build a godly home.

<u>Proverbs 24:3-4</u> – By wisdom a house is built, and through understanding it is established; through knowledge its rooms are filled with rare and beautiful treasures.

II. Will bear out the . .

<u>1 Samuel 3:12</u> – At that time I will carry out against Eli everything I spoke against his family—from beginning to end.

There is a high price to pay for disobedience.

<u>Lamentations 5:7</u> – Our ancestors sinned and are no more, and we bear their punishment.

Do not compromise your faith to please others.

Joshua 24:15 – But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.

A wise father will commit to the way of the Lord.

<u>Proverbs 16:3</u> – Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and he will establish your plans.

III.	Fails	to									

<u>1 Samuel 3:13</u> – For I told him that I would judge his family forever because of the sin he knew about; his sons blasphemed God, and he failed to restrain them.

As a father, failure is not an option.

<u>Proverbs 22:6</u> – Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it.

<u>Deuteronomy 6:6-7</u> – These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

Confess your failures to the Lord.

<u>Luke 15:18-19</u> – I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: "Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants."

A wise father will let his heavenly Father fix his failures.


<u>Psalm 51:10</u> – Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

<u>Jeremiah 18:4</u> – But the pot he was shaping from the clay was marred in his hands; so the potter formed it into another pot, shaping it as seemed best to him.
