

**Scripture:** Romans 12:1-2

**Synopsis:** There are so many things in life that change. For example, seasons change, we change the TV channel, and we change out dead batteries. However, the most difficult thing to change is our life. God has called each of us to be transformed. For this full transformation to take place, we must give every area of our life to our Lord and Savior. Yes, this can be hard to do. The reason we struggle to give it all to Christ is because old habits weigh us down, it is not pleasant seeing our faults, and this transformation can be painful to endure.

## Why is change so hard?
