## USBC Church Budget



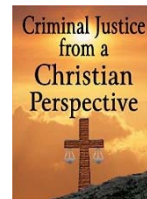

# “The Attitude of Giving”

**Scripture:** Luke 10:30-35 (NIV)

**Synopsis** – The parable of the Good Samaritan is a story about a stranger helping a wounded foe. However, this story also highlights the attitude of giving. Each character in this parable expressed the truth in their heart by the gift they gave or didn't give.

## The attitudes of giving:

I. What's yours is \_\_\_\_\_.

**Luke 10:30** – *In reply Jesus said: “A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he was attacked by robbers. They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead.*

**Exodus 20:15** – *You shall not steal.*

**Malachi 3:8-10** – *“Will a mere mortal rob God? Yet you rob me. “But you ask, ‘How are we robbing you?’ “In tithes and offerings. You are under a curse—your whole nation—because you are robbing me. Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the Lord Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.*

**We rob God in multiple ways.**

II. What's mine is \_\_\_\_\_.

**Luke 10:31-32** – *A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. So too, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side.*

**Giving is not about you, but about others.**

**1 Corinthians 10:24** – *No one should seek their own good, but the good of others.*

**Giving can involve getting your hands dirty.**

**James 2:14-17** – *What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to them, “Go in peace; keep warm and well fed,” but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.*

III. What's mine is \_\_\_\_\_.

**Luke 10:33-35** – *But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him. The next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper. “Look after him,” he said, “and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.”*

**Your attitude makes a difference in how you give.**

**Matthew 6:21** – *For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.*

**The greatest gift that you can give is yourself.**

**Romans 12:1** – *Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.*

**Without giving, there is no worship.**

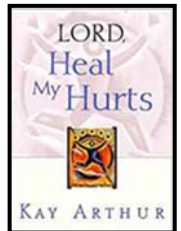
