# “We Make God Sick”

**Scripture:** Revelation 3:15-16 (NIV)

**Synopsis:** We don't often think about God getting sick. However, in the Book of Revelation, God reveals to us that He has a weak stomach. His stomach sickness has nothing to do with eating spoiled food or catching a nasty bug. His stomach virus is directly related to our behavior. So that we do not make God nauseous, we need to learn to live a healthy and obedient life.

## How to keep God from getting sick:

I. Do not ignore your \_\_\_\_\_.

**Revelation 3:15** – *I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other!*

**Matthew 23:28** – *In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness.*

**When it comes to our Christian faith, it is easy to play both sides of the fence.**

**God asks us to do something - check our spiritual temperature.**

**Christianity is not about convenience, but about commitment.**

II. Contact a \_\_\_\_\_.

**Revelation 3:16** – *So, because you are lukewarm--neither hot nor cold--I am about to spit you out of my mouth.*

**When you go to Jesus, the Great Physician, He is going to be perfectly honest about your condition.**

**If you do not do something about your spiritual sickness, it will make Christ nauseated.**

**There are times when Jesus gets sick and tired of the way His children behave.**

**The Great Physician has a cure for our sickness.**

III. Take the prescribed \_\_\_\_\_.

**Luke 10:34a** – *He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. ...*

**The thing that makes God sick is SIN!**

**1 John 1:9** – *If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.*

**Are we willing to change our lives for Jesus?**

**Do you want to make God feel good today? Tell Him you are sorry and that you want forgiveness.**
