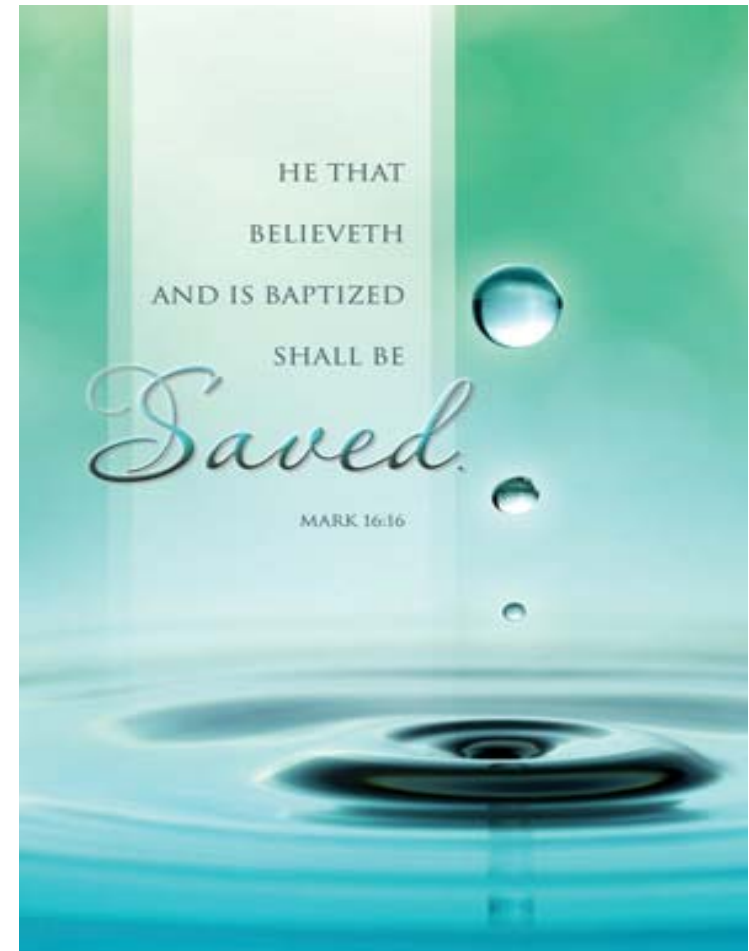

# “The Coming of Christ’s Kingdom” Part 2

Scripture: Matthew 6:9-13 (KJV)

## Matthew 6:9-13

*After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.*

## **What is the Kingdom of God?**

I. It is a place of God’s \_\_\_\_\_.

**Jesus told us to pray in a such manner that God’s will, will be accomplished upon this earth.**

Revelation 17:14 – *They will make war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will overcome them because he is Lord of lords and King of kings ...*

**Effective prayer is not bending God’s will to fit ours, but it is discovering God’s will and then accomplishing it.**

1 John 5:14 – *This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us.*

## **3 principles in praying for God’s will.**

- *The Surrender principle.*

Galatians 2:20 – *I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me.*

- *The Scripture principle.*

John 15:7 – *If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.*

- *The Spirit principle.*

Romans 8:26-27 – *In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for saints in accordance with God’s will.*

II. It is a place of God’s \_\_\_\_\_.

Hebrews 4:16 – *Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence ...*

**Since the throne is anointed with grace, you can enter into the presence of God with confidence.**

Ephesians 2:8 – *For it is by grace you have been saved, not of works, lest any man should boast.*
