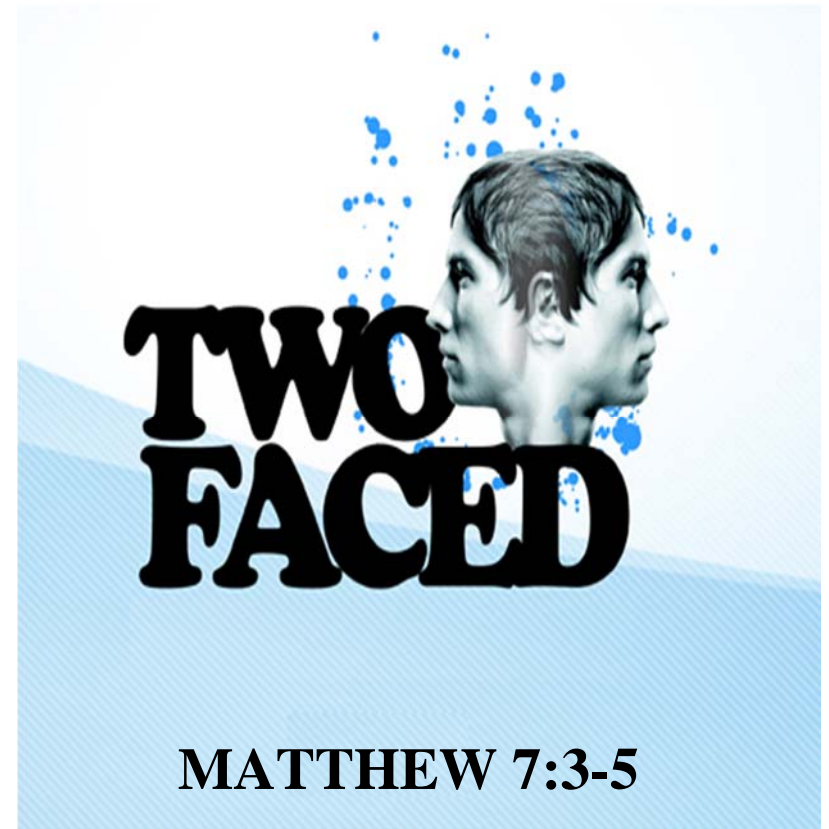

“Two Faced”

Scripture: Matthew 7:3-5 (NIV)

Synopsis: A person who is two faced is someone who pretends to be one thing, but behind your back they act totally different. Such people are also called hypocrites. It can be a challenge to get along with such a person, but God has a plan for how to spot a hypocrite and how to deal with a person who is two-faced.

Hypocrite/Two-Faced (def.) – *A person who pretends to be what he or she is not.*

We are quick to judge who we think may be a hypocrite, but most of us never consider whether we might be one.

The three marks of a hypocrite:

I. They major on the _____.

Matthew 7:3 – *Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye?*

So often we will look for the smallest discrepancy in others and use it for all its worth.

Little faults in others we see very large, and large faults in ourselves we see very small.

II. They want to be _____.

Matthew 7:4 – *How can you say to your brother, ‘Let me take the speck out of your eye,’ when all the time there is a plank in your own eye?*

It is easy to correct other people's problems, but it is hard to correct your own.

The destruction of self-centeredness:

- **A self-centered person never sees themselves as being self-centered.**
- **Self-centeredness can lead to the destruction of God's people.**
- **A self-centered person is more concerned about them being seen than Jesus being seen.**

Matthew 6:5 – *“When you pray, you are not to be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on the street corners so that they may be seen by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full.*

III. They make the situation _____.

Matthew 7:5 – *You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.*

A hypocritical person cannot help others.

A hypocrite leaves behind a destructive path.

Hypocrisy always makes the situation worse.

If you are pointing out the faults of others and not your own, you are a hypocrite.

Both the plank and the speck are condemned by God.
