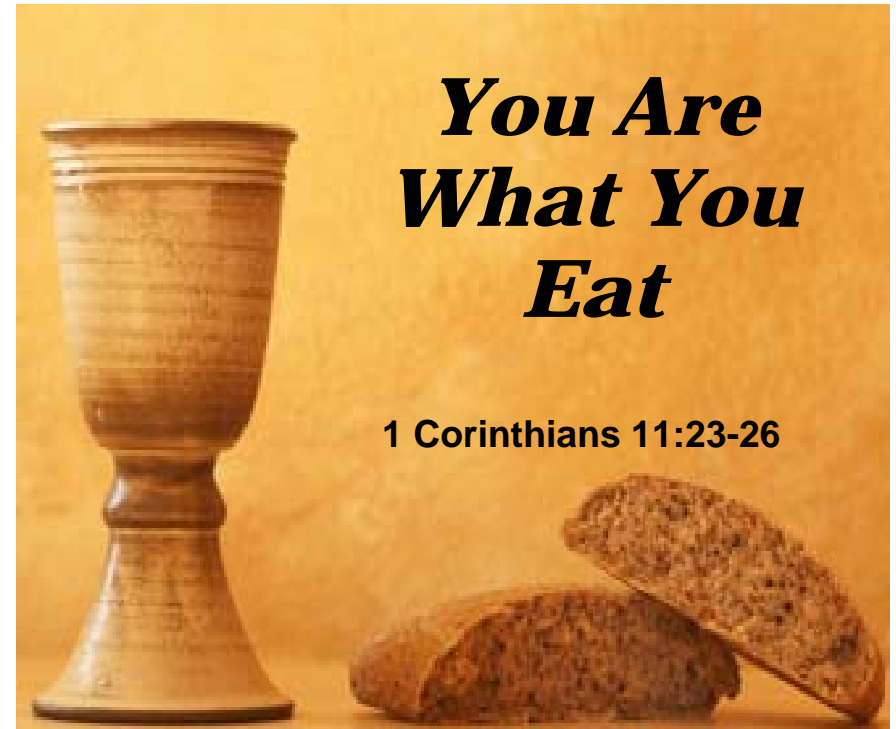

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (NIV)

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 – For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.” In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.” For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.

Why do we have the Lord’s Supper?

I. It was _____ by Christ.

1 Corinthians 11:23 – For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread,

1 Corinthians 11:24a – and when he had given thanks, ...

John 3:16 – For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Jesus knew that it was going to take His death to free us from our sins.

How thankful are you for what Christ did?

II. It is to _____ Christ.

1 Corinthians 11:24-25 – and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.” In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.”

Jesus is very clear in the fact that we are to remember Him.

There is so much more about Christ, than just His death.

When we observe the Lord’s Supper we are to remember our Savior, for His love and grace.

2 Timothy 2:8a – Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel, ...

III. It is for _____.

In 1 Corinthians 11:23-26, Jesus uses the word “you”, five times.

There is no way that we can stand before a Holy God with sin in our life.

1 Peter 3:18 – For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive in the Spirit.

The only way that you and I could be free from sin was to have a sinless sacrifice offered on our behalf.

John 8:36 – So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

Galatians 5:1 – It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

Super Seniors



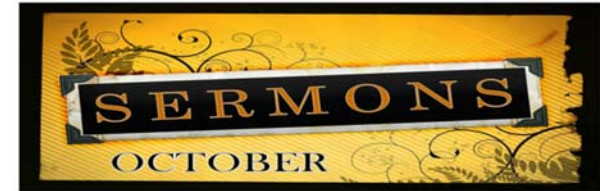
