**Scripture:** Matthew 2:1-12



<u>Thanksgiving Food Drive</u> (Collected foods which were donated to "*Damascus Help*").




<u>Samaritan's Purse</u> (Packed about 40 shoeboxes for "*Operation Christmas Child*").

the cards yourself. However, the church will be providing new church directories so that you can label your cards appropriately.


